Specify the lengths and circumferences up to the desired height according to the instructions given below.



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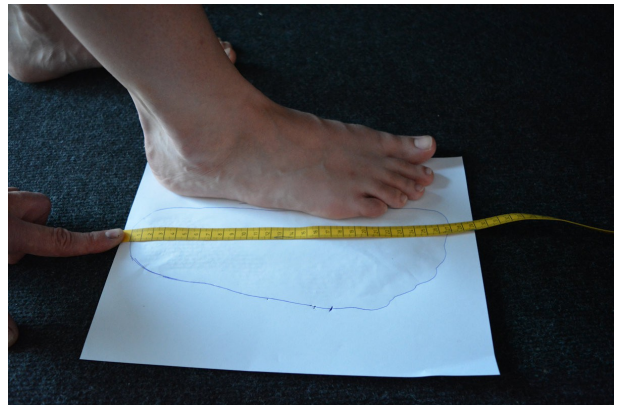
Step 1

Take a piece of paper (DIN A4), put your foot on as shown in the picture and draw its shape onto it. Remember to hold the pen vertically.



Step 2

Obtain the length of your foot by measuring the longest distance between the end of the heel and the tip of your big toe.



Step 3

Obtain Measurement A as shown in the picture.





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Step 4

Obtain Measurement B as shown in the picture.



Step 5

Starting from the bottom draw points or short lines on the leg with an equal distance of 10cm until You've reached the desired height of the bootleg. For drawing the points you can use an eyeliner.





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Step 6

When finished measure the circumference at each point You have drawn onto Your leg.



Step 7

Enter all measured lengths and circumferences into the dimension sheet.
